

Model Sayamprabha home project for the elderly to be extended to all districts

The Social Justice department will extend the Model Sayamprabha home project for the elderly to all districts of the State.

The project is currently being implemented in Neyyattinkara in the capital district under a tripartite agreement between the department, HelpAge India, and the Neyyattinkara municipality.

Pilot project
The home had been started as a pilot project, sources said.

The project will now be extended to the remaining 13 districts, Social Justice Director Arun S. Nair said here.

The Social Justice department also plans to increase the number of Sayamprabha homes in the State from 85 to 140 this financial year.

The scheme was rolled out in 2018-19 by upgrading day-care centres functioning under the Local Self-government depart-

ment into Sayamprabha homes.

Mr. Arun Nair said the department planned to select 10 day-care homes under the local bodies in each district and associate them with the Social Justice department to improve services for the elderly.

These would be the Sayamprabha homes.

Modern facilities
Of these, one home in each district would get an upgrade into a Model Sayamprabha home that would have modern facilities and act as a resource hub.

The homes will function in a hub-and-spoke model with the model homes as the nodal centre and the Sayamprabha homes as spokes.

This would enable provision of specialised services such as psychological support, upskilling, physiotherapy, nutrition needs and diet training, art and physical activity, legal training, and digital literacy to the elderly.

Productive ageing
Mr. Arun Nair said that unlike day-care centres that were usually a place where the elderly could come together and maybe have food, there would be a uniformity in the functioning of Sayamprabha homes, with additional services provided to the elderly to realise the objective of productive ageing.

Master trainers
The department was also mulling how to use the services of highly qualified elderly as master trainers. Such individuals would be included in a skill bank.

The Sayamprabha guidelines have been submitted to the government in order to unify and improve the functioning of the homes.

NoRKA campaign to create awareness on various ID cards

The NoRKA-Roots, a field agency under the State government's Department of Non-Resident Keralites Affairs (NoRKA), is organising a month-long special campaign from July 1 to 31 to create awareness on various ID cards and services provided to expatriate Keralites around the world. The campaign is aimed at creating awareness about services like Pravasi ID Card, Student ID Card, NRK ID Card and Norka Pravasi Raksha Insurance (NPRI), a health insurance scheme for critical illnesses.

The campaign period can also be utilised to clear doubts for those who have taken ID cards and to renew the cards for those who have delayed renewal. The various ID cards are helpful for the government in locating expatriate Keralites around the world and intervening in times of need.

Non-residents between the ages of 18 and 70 who are working or residing

abroad for more than six months will get a Pravasi ID card and Norka Pravasi Raksha Insurance (NPRI) services. Those who have completed the admission procedures for studying abroad and those who are currently studying abroad will get a Student ID card. NRK ID card will be available to NRIs who have been living or working in other States of India for two years.

Valid for 3 years
The ID cards are valid for three years and Norka Pravasi Raksha Insurance for one year. Insurance cover of ₹5 lakh for accidental death and ₹2 lakh for disabilities will be provided. Norka Pravasi ID card can be used as one of the sponsor's identity documents for admission to NRI seats. Applications for all the ID cards and services can be made through the official website of Norka Roots www.norkaroots.kerala.gov.in.

T.N. tourist killed, 10 injured as MUV falls into gorge

A 60-year-old tourist from Tamil Nadu was killed and 10 others were injured after a multi-utility vehicle (MUV) they were travelling in fell into a gorge along the Pothamedu-Aatukad road near Munnar in Idukki on Tuesday.

According to the police, the deceased has been identified as Prakash, a resident of Tiruvallur in Tamil Nadu.

The vehicle was transporting 11 people, including the driver, to a resort after a sightseeing trip in the morning.

The accident occurred

around 9.30 a.m. The driver lost control of the vehicle while he was reversing it and it plunged nearly 50 feet into a gorge and skidded to a tea plantation. The vehicle hit Mr. Prakash, who was standing

outside giving directions to the driver, before falling into the gorge. Trapped under the vehicle, Mr. Prakash sustained serious injuries and died at a private hospital in Munnar.
